School Information

Tashkent International School (TIS), is a not-for-profit, independent, co-educational day school governed by a board of trustees from the parent community. TIS serves the international population, including the diplomatic and expatriate community.

Co-curricular Activities and Athletics

TIS has a comprehensive and balanced program that complements our academic programs and fosters the importance of holistic excellence. A partial list of offerings include: Owl Project, Model United Nations, Student Council, Aquaponics, Cancer Crusaders, Greener Tomorrows, Honey Project, theater production, and orchestra. TIS also offers competitive activities such as cross country, volleyball, basketball, soccer, and track and field. These offerings are designed to supports the DP students in meeting the expectations of the CAS program.

Uzbekistan National Scholarship

Three full tuition high school scholarships are offered to academically talented national students entering Grade 10 who meet the scholastic criteria and demonstrate financial need. Past TIS scholarship students have been accepted into top universities on full and partial scholarships in the United States, Canada and Europe.

IB Diploma Program (IBDP)

All students in Grade 11 and 12 are enrolled in IB Diploma courses and complete the final IB examinations. The IBDP is a challenging pre-university program aimed at students age 16 to 19. The qualification is widely recognized by the world's leading universities.

To receive the IB Diploma, students must fulfill the following requirements:

- Enroll in three Higher Level (HL) courses and three Standard Level (SL) courses and achieve a score of at least 24 points. Points are accumulated based on internal and external assessments completed throughout the two years of study, as well as the final IB examinations;
- · Successfully complete Theory of Knowledge;
- Successfully complete a 4,000-word Extended Essay on a topic of their choice; and
- Achieve a balance of Creativity, Activity and Service (CAS).


Grading System & Transcript

The TIS assessment system follows established IB criteria. Equivalence with the U.S. grading system is based on consultation with the IB and other leading international schools. Given the diversity of the student body and the transience of the international community, TIS does not rank its students.
