## WHO WE ARE

Tashkent International School (TIS) offers a vibrant learning environment where students are empowered to challenge themselves, explore boundaries and make connections to create a positive difference in our world. Established in 1994 by the UN and the embassies of the USA, Great Britain, France, Germany and Korea, TIS is an International Baccalaureate World School accredited by the Council of International Schools and the New England Association of Schools and Colleges. TIS offers International Baccalaureate Primary Years Programme, Middle Years Programme, and Diploma Programme for students from age 3 to 18. TIS fosters international-mindedness and global citizenship and currently has students from over 40 different countries.

TIS is housed on a 5 hectare park like campus that serves as a dynamic and welcoming space for our entire community. The campus is used to offer a full Co-Curricular Activities program giving students opportunities to explore, develop, compete and serve. The campus is always buzzing with community events including campouts, picnics, art exhibitions, performances, concerts, market days, fundraisers and tournaments. # A DAY IN THE LIFE OF TIS

Classes begin at o8:20 everyday and students are dismissed at 15:20. Co-curricular Activities and clubs start at 15:20 and continue in the afternoon until 17:00.

Both the Elementary and Secondary run on a 10 day rotating schedule that allows for students to work with a variety of teachers across a diverse range of subjects. During break and lunch times times students can make use of the whole campus to play and relax. Students move around campus visiting subject specific areas such as our Black Box Theater, Visual Arts studios, Maker Spaces, Design labs, Science labs, Music rooms and collaborative learning spaces that encourage students to develop across disciplines.

Both the Elementary and the Secondary School have their own Social/Emotional Counselor and a team of Learning Support teachers who work with students who face barriers to their learning. We also have a team of English Language Learners (ELL) teachers working to support our students who are developing their English language skills.

Early mornings, afternoons and weekends are filled by our yearly athletics program where our students compete in a variety of sports against local schools as well as other international schools from around Central Asia and Eastern Europe.
