

Non-North American Calendar Applications

Student applicants who apply for enrollment mid-year at TIS whose current school does not follow the standard North American calendar must apply for the grade level that they completed during their school year. This often applies to applications from South Korea, Japan, Australia, New Zealand, Singapore, or other national school systems whose school calendars differ from the TIS academic North American/European calendar. TIS will take into account standardized testing data and international school experience to determine exceptions to the grade placement.

Example: The Australian school year ends in December and a family transfers to TIS in January, and the child has completed Australia Grade 7, students will generally be required to complete the TIS school year at the same grade level.

Grade Placement Chart for SY 2024-2025

Students applying for admission to the high school program (G9-12) must demonstrate the potential to graduate from high school before they reach twenty years of age.
